

GARDEN DESIGN PLAN

An animated illustration showing proposed ideas for your new garden. The garden will be softened by using curves to create a sense of flow around the garden, with two key circle seating areas which will create a feeling of sitting within an enclosed space without shutting off areas of the garden.

The main body of the garden, the lawn area, will be new artificial lawn which is low maintenance and suitable for year-round use. The planted borders will be a low maintenance, predominantly evergreen shrubs which will provide year-round seasonal interest and draw your attention to specimen plants.

The paving will be very contemporary and have a contrasting edge around the key areas. Suggested paving materials would be either a porcelain paving or sawn sandstone paving, both offer minimalist style with very contemporary banding. The paved areas do have curved edges, which assists with pulling your attention into the flow around the garden.
